



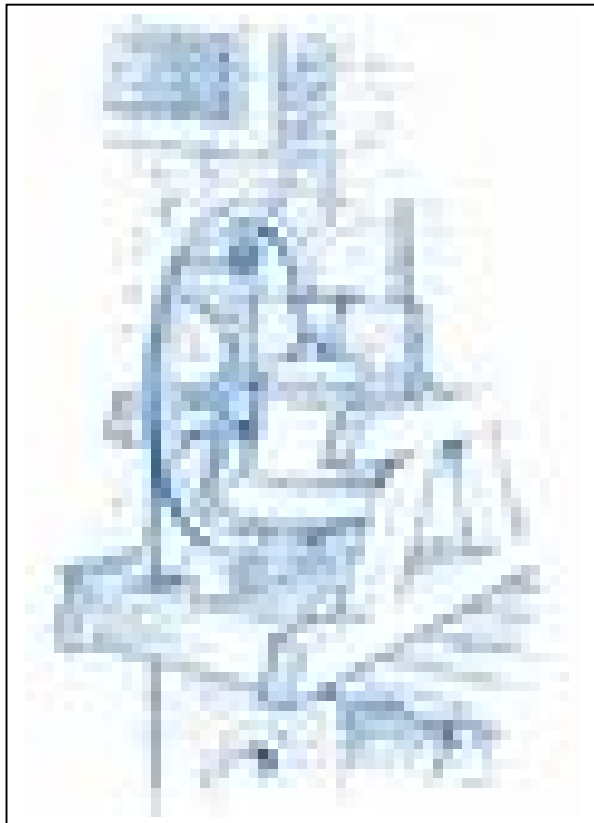

This is a six bell tower:

The bells were cast in 1822 at Taylor's of Loughborough and restored by the same company in 1934, with the assistance of J. Faggetter of Pirbright. In 2005 the bells and frames were overhauled with the assistance of the Guildford Guild Bell Restoration Fund.
